Sacramental Prep

- Baptism** - Class required for parents before children receive the Sacrament of Baptism.
- First Eucharist** - Typically begins in 2nd grade following a full year of religious education.
- Confirmation** - Begins in 9th grade following a full year of religious education.
- Marriage** - Contact the Pastor at least 6 months in advance of the wedding.
- RCIA**- Rite of Christian Initiation - for those interested in receiving the Sacraments of Initiation and joining the Catholic Church.

Liturgy

- Altar Server** - Open to children 4th grade and above who would like to assist the presider at liturgy.
- Children's Liturgy of the Word** - Leaders gather with our children ages 4-9 to experience the Liturgy of the Word presented in an age appropriate venue. Training is provided.
- Eucharistic Minister** - Assist with the distribution of the Eucharist.
- Lector** - Proclaims the scripture readings to the assembled faith community.
- Music Minister** - Support the assembly's prayer and enhance times of reflection. Join our Adult Choir, Assisi Youth Music Ministry, and Cantor Ministry.
- Usher** - Greet God's people as they assemble for prayer. Welcome friends and strangers and assure that any special needs will be met during the Mass celebration.
- Altar Linen Care** - Team members launder and iron altar linens on a rotating schedule.

Faith Formation

- Catechist** - Lead and supervise a religious education class. Plan and prepare lesson for each session. Indicate preference Pre-K to 5th grade ___ 6th-12th___
- Co-Catechist** - Share responsibilities above with another catechist. Indicate preference Pre-K to 5th grade ___ 6th-12th___
- Catechist Assistant** - Provide support to catechist leading the session. Indicate preference Pre-K to 5th grade ___ 6th-12th___
- Faith Formation Substitute** - Volunteer on-call to fill in for a catechist or assistant as needed. Indicate preference Pre-K to 5th grade ___ 6th-12th___
- Adult Faith Formation Committee** - Lead small group sessions of adult faith formation programs such as bible studies and other catholic study programs.
- RCIA Team** - Work with those preparing to enter the Catholic Church.
- Youth Ministry Volunteer** - Be a consistent adult presence at youth ministry events and sessions.

Health and Pastoral Ministry

- Blood Drive** - Assists with check-in of blood donors, providing snacks and drinks.
- Prayer Team** - Prays for the prayer intentions requested for a minimum of 7 days.
- Blood Pressure Screening Team**- Members take blood pressure after Masses once a month.
- Postal Ministry Team** - Members create cards and/or writes the notes of comfort to those suffering with grief, illness, or other difficulties.
- Prison Minister** - Members bring the Eucharist and the Word of God to prisoners in a local prison or jail.

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Health and Pastoral Ministry, continued

- Senior Group** – Join other semi-retired and retired parishioners once a month for fun and fellowship.
- Meals that Heal Team** – Provide meals to fellow parishioners experiencing illness or crisis.
- Living with Cancer Support Group** – Support group for those living with Cancer and their loved ones.
- Medical Equipment Loan Program** – Provides medical equipment for loan to parishioners in need.
- Faith Community Nurse Consult Services** – Consultation on health issues, education, health care advocacy and health related referrals.
- Bereavement Hospitality Team** - Members set-up, manage, and clean-up funeral receptions held at St. Francis upon request.
- Pastoral Visitor** - Visit and bring the Eucharist to parishioners who are homebound due to injuries, illness, or aging.
- Caring for Christ Minister** - Provide transportation, run errands, and give respite companion service (no medical care required).

More Opportunities

- Knights of Columbus** - Fraternal organization of Catholic men in service to the parish and community.
- Ladies of Hope** - Caring group of Catholic women in service to the parish and community.
- Social Concerns** - Provide service and support for those in need.
- Food Pantry** - Process donations and distribute food to those in need.
- Community Formation** - Build our community through social events.
- Pastoral Council** – Assists the Pastor in carrying out the mission of the Church at the parish level.

More Opportunities, continued

- Finance Committee** – Appointed financial professionals that plan and monitor the parish budget/ financial recording and reporting.
- Maintenance Committee** - Provide light repair services as needed.
- Hospitality Team** – Manage refreshments and snacks for Hospitality Sundays and parish functions as needed.
- Office Support** - Organizing data, assisting with materials preparation
- Decorating Committee** - Prepares the worship space for all liturgical celebrations.
- Christmas Bazaar** - Serve at our largest parish fundraiser. Volunteers are needed to prepare for and work during the Bazaar.
- Gardening Angels** - Help maintain the beauty of our flowering plants and shrubs.
- Development Committee** – Works in coordination with the Pastor, Pastoral Council, and Finance committee for the purpose of long range planning.
- Decorating Committee** - Prepares the worship space for all liturgical celebrations.

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
